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## Research and refine

The university requested a Voluntary Product Accessibility Template (VPAT) for each program to assess its accessibility and uncover conformance opportunities. Following the university's review and approval, the final VPAT criteria informed the component modifications. The Center for Leadership Studies implemented in the programs and their accompanying materials.

Discussions with the university identified their desire to address accessibility while maintaining the quality of experience for learners who didn't need those adjustments; depict conceptual material, like the Situational Leadership® framework, in an easy-to-understand manner; and promote better understanding and flow for all learners. Frequent touchpoints with them allowed The Center for Leadership Studies to continually refine and adapt the approach to best meet the needs of the university's user population.

## Broad access, focused approach

Specific design features focused on the university's objective to enable those with physical or cognitive impairments to consume and benefit from an equal learning experience.

This effort included updates to the online modules and supporting components, such as content-specific handouts, Participant Workbook, Study Guides and participant certificate generators, which were optimized and evaluated for screen reader integration and 508 alignment. Extensive functional and usability testing was conducted prior to client delivery to satisfy internal standards of excellence and gauge the university users' seamless experience. The collaborative preplanning and communication with the university yielded successful, on-time delivery of both 508-compliant programs and their supplemental materials, expanding their leadership development catalog with on-tap, accessible programs.
